FAO MONEY AND MEDALS: NEWSLETTER 21

Dear Friend,

Orders for all Panels 1B have now been met, and it is expected that orders for Panels 7 and 8 and for Album 6 will be despatched in July, after the arrival of the Maldive coins.

2. On Panel 1B, we illustrate alongside how it is sold, with only two coins. Of the 11 missing coins, the 1974 India 50 rupees was issued in some 82,000 pieces; the Vatican coins in 90,000 sets additional to the 10,000 bought by FAO for Album 1 and now sold out; and the two Order of Malta in 7,000 sets additional to the 10,000 distributed by FAO in Album 1. The 1974 India coin is freely available from dealers in Europe and North America, but the 1968 sets will be much harder to obtain, as is the case for many coins issued nine years ago.

4. Ceres/Agricola Medals

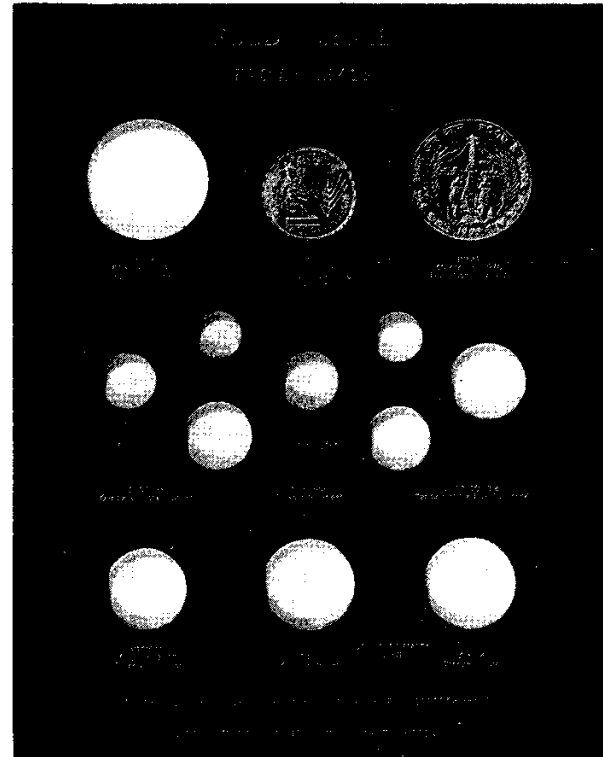
For our new Ceres and Agricola medals we have prepared a special panel housing to contain the six first issues. The panel displays the portrait side in 50 mm silver edition, and the medal reverse in a 28 mm aluminium edition. The medals housed in the first panel feature Sirimavo Bandaranaike, Far Pahlavi, Dorothy Nyembe, Fatima Abdel Mahmoud, Grace of Monaco, and Julius Nyerere. The price of the complete panel is \$130, and may be paid with the order form overleaf.
