Dear Collector,

As promised in Note 6 of 25 June, we now illustrate the Ceres medal featuring Olave Baden-Powell. The medal will be released in late September. Lady Baden-Powell, widow of the founder of the Scout movement, has been World Chief Guide since 1930. On 22 February 1974 she will reach her 85th birthday, in a life still very active in the service of young people. Over the past several years the 6,500,000-strong Girl Guide and Girl Scout movement has, in many developing countries, become increasingly involved in nutrition and rural development work, with girls and mothers among the less privileged sections of the population.

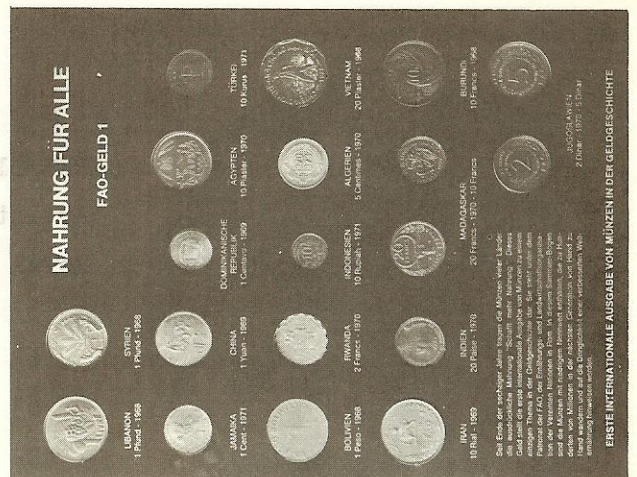
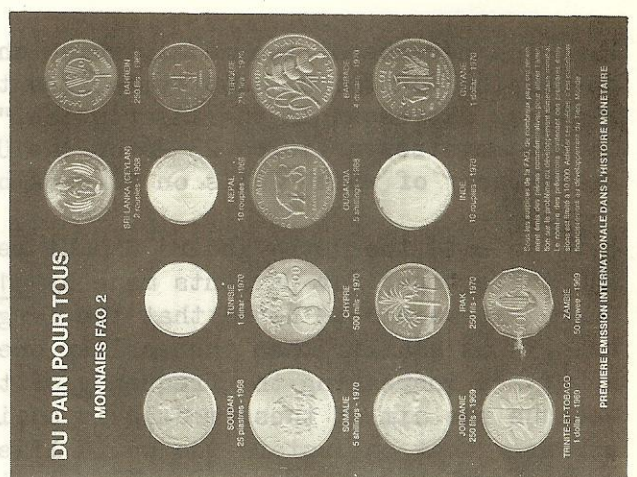
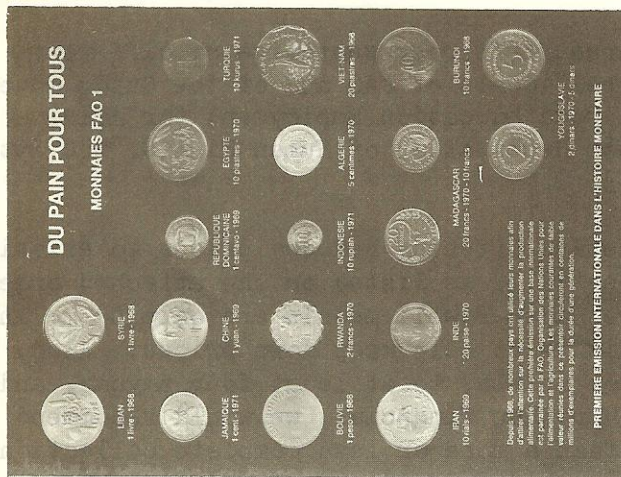

2. The reverse of the medal, which shows three girls representative of different developing countries, also symbolizes the shared ideals of FAO and of the Guide movement, as expressed in the inscription "Toward Food Education Employment for All". This summarizes articles 23-26 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the 25th anniversary of which falls on 10 December 1973.

3. As with the Ceres/Indira Gandhi medal, we are offering reduced prices to existing FAO collectors, for payments made by 31 October 1973, as listed on the attached order form. It should be noted that the large Olave Baden-Powell medals are only 63 mm in size, 5 mm smaller than the earlier ones. This is to help keep down prices. Also, as we are increasing the frequency of the Ceres medals, to at least four a year, and because the aim of these medals is social rather than financial, we would recommend strongly that collectors who would like to obtain a more or less complete collection buy only the bronze 63 mm (or 68 mm) size. Future Ceres will now include Coretta Scott King, Angela Christian, Matsuyo Yamamoto, Alva Myrdal and Attiya Inayatullah.

4. The earlier Ceres medals may be ordered with the payment form attached to Collector Note 5, except that the gold medals are presently \$60 or equivalent, as with the Olave Baden-Powell medal from 1 November 1973 onward.

5. On the facing page we illustrate the French, German and Italian versions of FAO Money Panels 1 and 2, the display collection of 35 of the first Food for All coins. Each of the six panels is the exact size of this page. The panels and other FAO money items may be ordered by the payment form attached to Collector Note 6.

6. Finally, we have noted that some collectors may be concerned at having bought more than one FAO Money Album I, but cannot afford the outlay for a similar number of Albums 2, 3 and following. If therefore you would like to exchange an extra Album I against an Album 2 on a one-to-one basis, please write and let us know, and we will do our best to help you continue your collection, at reasonable cost. We are trying to give value for money, but not at the cost of your personal Food for All!
